

Annual Meeting and Elections

will be held Thursday, April 24th, 2025 at the Links of Northfork Golf Club starting at 7pm. Last year, voter turnout was 62/274 (23%), with just 37 (14%) households attending the meeting. If you have not already received one, you will soon be receiving a ballot in the mail. Please vote. Kurt Kettner Resignation

Kurt has submitted his resignation from the Board effective April 24. Consequently, one of the two open Board seats being filled on at the April 24 homeowners meeting will be for the two years remaining in his three year term. The other open seat will be for a full three year term. Unless the two winners of the election agree otherwise, the candidate receiving the most votes will fill the three year term and the other will complete the two year term. Kurt remains President until his seat is filled as the election results are announced at the meeting. The Board will select a new President at the first Board meeting after April 24.
